

# **GUGC Social Sport Guidelines**

**All users must agree to the following guidelines before participating in any Social Sport competition, failure to do so will result in exclusion from the competition. These guidelines are in addition to the Social Sport Terms & Conditions.**

## **COVID Health Related Conditions**

- All users must maintain social distancing at all times – 1.5m from others;
- All users must maintain good hygiene at all times – wash your hands, use sanitiser, cough into your elbow or a tissue, throw tissues away immediately and wash your hands;
- Anyone who is feeling sick with symptoms such as fever, sore throat, cough or shortness of breath will not be permitted in the venue. Please ensure that you stay home until you are feeling better;
- If you identify as someone in a high-risk vulnerability category for COVID-19, we advise that you consider the advice from government health authorities before coming to the Centre;
- This will be an “Arrive, Train/play, Go” set-up. Please be mindful about gathering before or after training – staff will ask you to move on should you not abide by social distancing requirements;
- All chairs, tables, benches and couches will not be in use within the G32 area;
- No spectators, only those who are playing are allowed to be in the facility
- Maximum capacity limits apply per venue at any one time;
- Hand sanitiser will be available at each facility and wash basins at venues with attached toilet blocks;
- All users are to come dressed and ready to play, there are no changerooms or showers available at the venue
- All users are to bring their own filled drink bottle, there is no access to water fountains at the venue;
- These guidelines have been put in place so you can enjoy the centre safely, failure to implement such guidelines successfully will mean closure of the venue;
- Please respect all staff at the venue, these guidelines have been put in place so you can enjoy the Social Sport season safely, failure to implement such guidelines successfully will mean postponement of the competition.

## **Game Day Responsibilities and conditions**

- Players can only arrive 15 minutes before they play
- Every player must check in via contactless registration
- If possible, players are encouraged to bring sanitiser to every game.
- Players must walk directly onto the field/pool or court
- Teams will have one half of the field/pool or court for a social distancing warm up
- All game will have a strict start and finish time with no overtime or catch up time.
- Teams will have a 2 minute half time break and must maintain 1.5m at all times
- Teams must not shake hands at the conclusion of the game
- One round of teams will leave then the next round of teams will be allowed to enter
- Balls, equipment and sitting surfaces will be cleaned after each game
- Bag area will be set up and social sport coordinator will monitor the items.

### **Arrival**

- All players to enter and exit the facility from the western side (Olsen Ave side)
- Car parking is available on the western side (Olsen Ave side)
- Players will check verbally with staff checking players in
- Players will be marshalled directly onto the field

### **Game**

- Referee will provide a player brief at the start of each game covering the additional COVID Rules to Social Sport. These are the rules outlined by the relevant National Sport Organisation (NSO)
- Strict dead ball rules (no touching the ball with your hands in soccer, everyone spaces themselves out). These rules will be included in the briefing and reminded during the game
- No handshake at the end of the game
- No toss to start the game
- Players are encouraged to replicate the post-game chat online through the GUGC Sport Facebook page or their own.

### **Departure**

- After the game ends players have 5 minutes to leave the venue. This will be timed and marshalled with potential penalties to teams and players who do not adhere to these rules or the direction of the Social Sport Coordinator.
- The referee will guide all players back to the exit via the nominated exit point and ensure they leave immediately.
