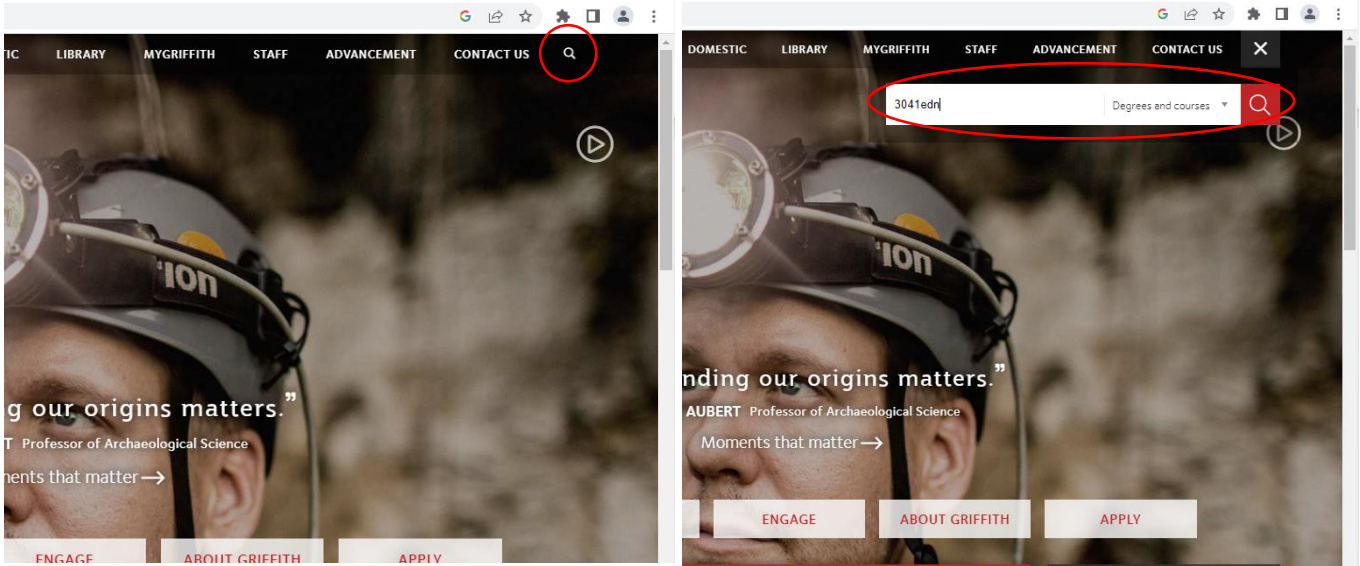


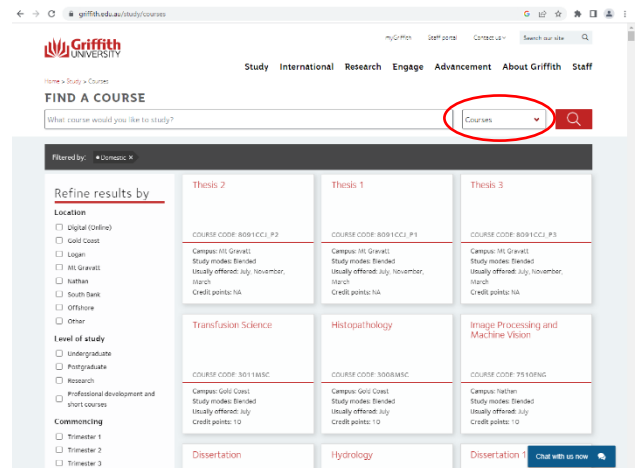
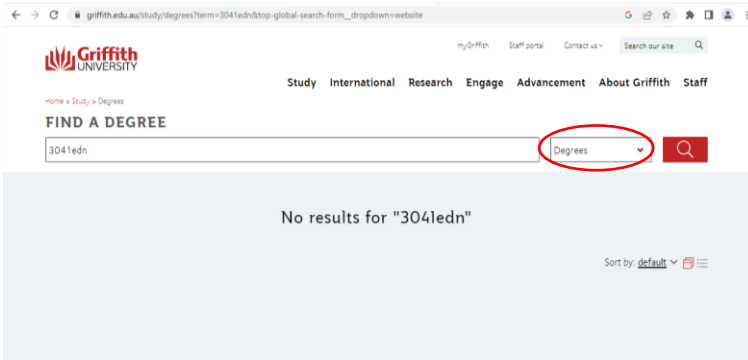
FINDING ASSESSMENT INFORMATION

How to find assessment information for individual courses

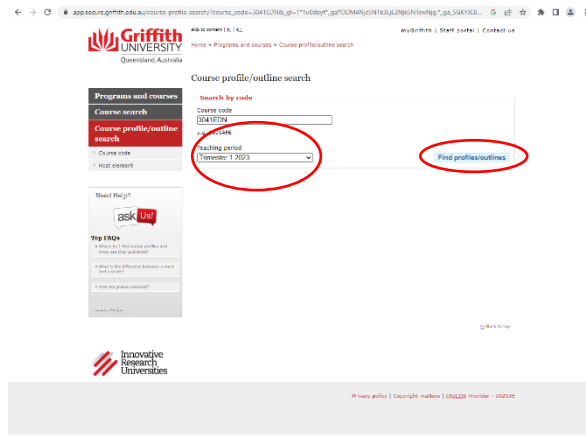
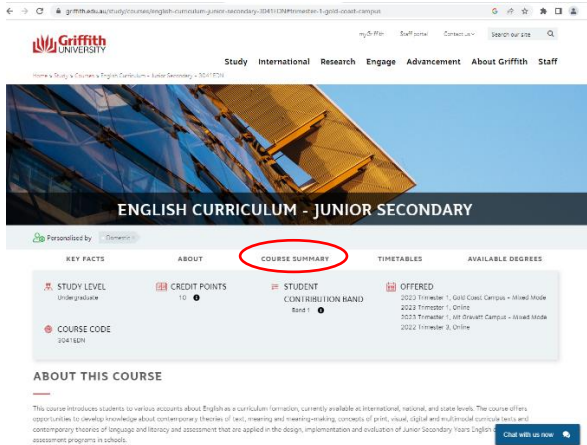
1. Open the Griffith University website by clicking [here](#). In the top right-hand corner is the symbol of a magnifying glass (the 'search' tool).
2. Searching in this tool bar will not bring up the unit but will redirect to the correct page.



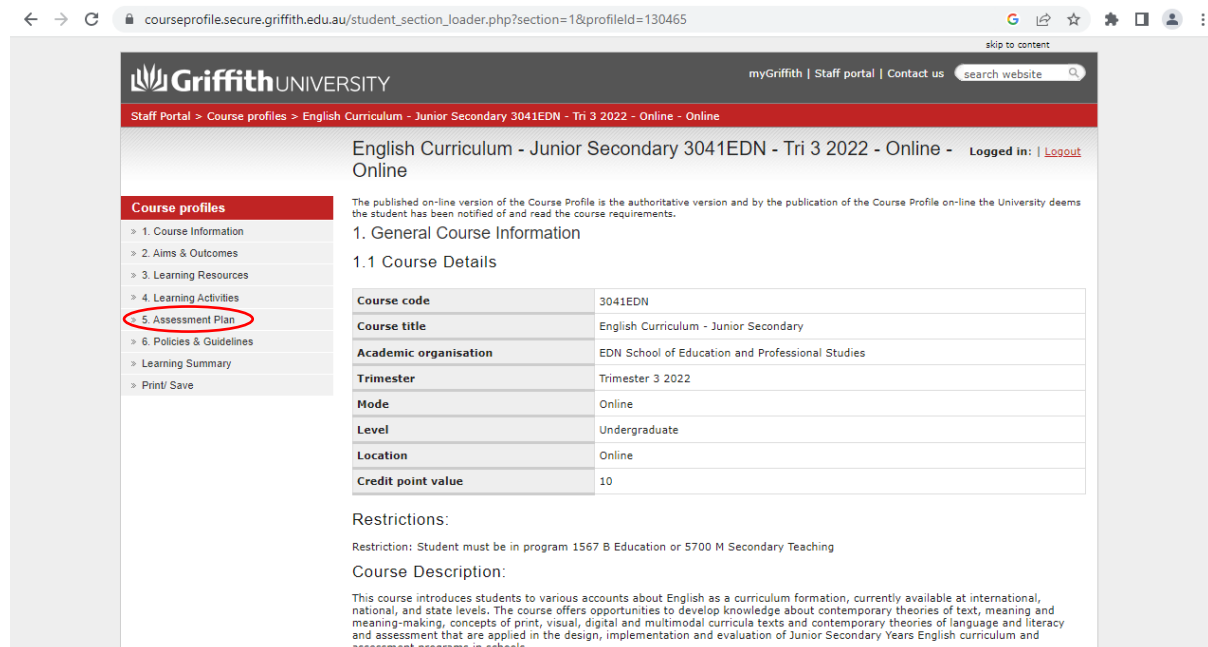
3. The page will return an error message. Select the "Degrees" drop down box and select "Courses".
4. This will bring up the main course search page. Retype the course code in the search bar.



- This search should take you directly to the specific course page, unless there are several courses with the same code (rare).
- On the course page, under the heading “About This Course”, select “View Course Profiles” – usually under the paragraph blurb about the course. This will bring up the course handbook. Select enrolment period (e.g., T1, 2023). Be aware, some courses do not follow the standard trimester structure. Select “Find profiles/outlines”. This will return the course offerings (e.g., Online, Gold Coast, Nathan, etc. – referring to the mode of the course). Find the correct offering and select “full course profile”.



- This will redirect you to the course profile main page (general course information). On the left-hand side, there are many tabs – select “Assessment Plan”. This will give an overview of the assessment, due dates, weight etc., and in-depth information on the tasks.
